

John 6:41-59
The Bread of Life (part 2)

1. Introduction

- a. Context:
 - i. The people loved the bread from the day before
 - ii. They rejected the Bread of Life on this day
- b. Question: What kind of bread do you seek?

2. Where did the Bread come from? (vv. 41-46)

- a. “*from heaven*” (vv. 32, 33, 38, 41, 42, 50, 51, 58)
- b. Responses:
 - i. Negative response: Grumbling & rejection (vv. 41-42).
 - ii. Positive response: Coming & receiving Christ (vv. 44-45).
 - iii. Note: The negative response is a work of self. The positive response is a work of God (v. 44)

3. What’s the difference between this Bread & other bread? (47-51)

- a. Other bread doesn’t give eternal life (v. 49)
- b. He is the Bread of life!
- c. Application: He alone can satisfy

4. How can we receive this Bread? (vv. 52-59)

- a. We must partake of Christ, not simply know about Him
- b. We must receive His sacrificial death on our behalf

5. Invitation

- a. “*Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!*” –Ps. 34:8
